Chief Master Sergeant “Les” Bramlett is the Command Chief Master Sergeant of the 15th Wing, Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam, Hawaii. In this position he serves as the principal adviser to the wing commander on enlisted issues. His responsibilities include advising the commander on all matters affecting the health, morale, and welfare of assigned enlisted personnel. The wing operates the C-17A, C-37A, C-40B, F-22A, and KC-135R, while also providing command functions to operate the airfield at Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam. The wing, in partnership with the Hawaii Air National Guard, employs Total Force combat and peacetime support to operations across Hawaii and throughout the Pacific Theater.



Chief Bramlett is a native of Memphis, Tennessee and he entered the Air Force in 1991. The Chief has served in numerous Air Force and joint leadership positions at the squadron, group and MAJCOM level with assignments in Illinois, Missouri, California and Texas. He deployed in support of Joint Task Force-Bravo (USSOUTHCOM), Operations ENDURING FREEDOM, IRAQI FREEDOM, and Combined Joint Task Force - Horn of Africa (USCENTCOM).
